### Worship

Worship is essential to the growing faith of a follower of God. While there are many different ways to worship, we hope that you will feel comfortable enough to worship with us in singing.

During our singing to God, if you want to raise your hands, clap or say "Amen" or "Hallelujah", go right ahead. We want to be worshipers of God in spirit and in truth (John 4:24). We seek to be free to express our love to God in ways that will be in order and pleasing to Him.

### Communion

We follow the early church example of weekly participation of the Lord's Supper (Acts 20:7). After prayer and meditation of the sacrifice of what Jesus has done for each one of us, we invite all disciples of Christ to join with us in this meal. This is not a ritual or act to be taken lightly. The Lord's Supper is a way the church can commune with our Lord.

### Offering

We also follow the New Testament practice of receiving an offering to our Lord. By giving to the Lord, we show our love and devotion to Christ. Giving is a practice of worship that is both apart of the Old and New Testament so we continue the practice of giving not only of our money, but of ourselves as an act of worship. (Romans 12:1-2)
